Enrollment

Since accurate enrollment and attendance records are essential both to obtain state financial reimbursement and to fulfill the district's responsibilities under the attendance laws, staff shall be diligent in maintaining such records.

Students without a legal residence shall not be required to present proof of residency in order to be enrolled. All other age, immunization and other enrollment requirements must be met.

The superintendent, or his/her designee, shall develop procedures for enrolling students and recording attendance. Consistent with state law, when enrolling a student who has attended school in another school district, the parent and student will be required to briefly indicate in writing whether or not the student has any history of offenses considered as "exceptional misconduct" by Enumclaw District policy; prior placement in a special education program; any past, current or pending discipline actions; any history of violent behavior or convictions, adjudications or diversion agreements, and any health conditions affecting the student's educational needs.
