Title 1 Parent Involvement

The following will serve as guidelines for the involvement of parents in the planning, operation, review and evaluation of the Title 1 program.

Development of School Plan

In the spring of each school year, the Title 1 staff will work cooperatively with various stakeholders in the process of developing their school Title 1 plan for the following school year. This plan shall include an emphasis on the process for identification of students, the instructional strategies and focus of the building program, the coordination efforts with the regular program, and efforts to promote and involve parents in the program. The district will sponsor an annual parent meeting for the Title 1 Program where these plans will be shared along with other specific information about each building's program.

Annual Compact

In the fall of each school year, the Title 1 staff will work with parents of their students to develop a compact for their program. This compact will outline the ways in which parents and school staff will work together to improve individual student academic achievement and school performance.

Activities for Parent Involvement

Title 1 staff will identify activities or other support mechanisms for involving parents in the support of their students' learning. Title 1 funds may be used alone or in conjunction with other funding sources to accomplish these activities.
