

On January 6, 2015, NAC (architects for our bond projects) loaded a school bus with our Enumclaw High School Predesign team and took them on a tour of three recently built high schools in our area. They toured:

- Bonney Lake High School – Sumner School District built in 2005
- Lakes High School – Clover Park School District built in 2010
- Emerald Ridge High School - Puyallup School District built in 2001

During their tour, they noticed some common themes in the three buildings:

- Single (or minimal) entrances into building
- Flexible learning places, optional movable walls, use of windows for natural lighting
- All buildings had two floors
- Arts programs have classroom, practice and performing spaces
- Technical programs have spaces that replicate industry
- Athletic and Fitness areas are appropriate and flexible to accommodate classroom use and afterschool practices and events (games and matches)
- Secured grounds
- Availability for community use in the evenings

The Predesign team will use this site visit along with the extensive reading and researching they have been doing to begin to build a design concept for the new Enumclaw High School. This initial design work is expected to be completed in early March.

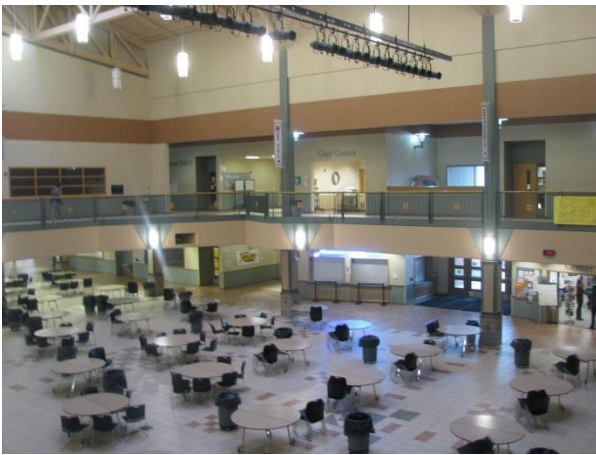

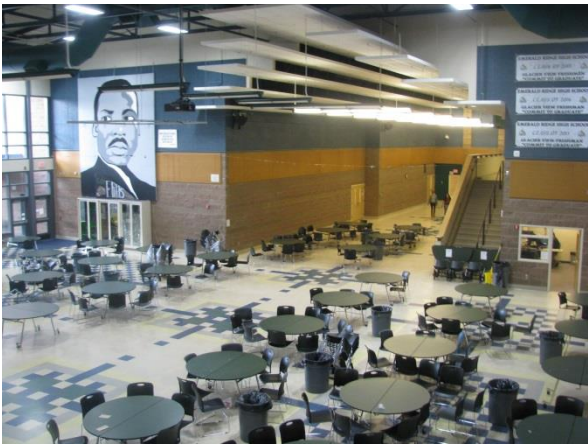

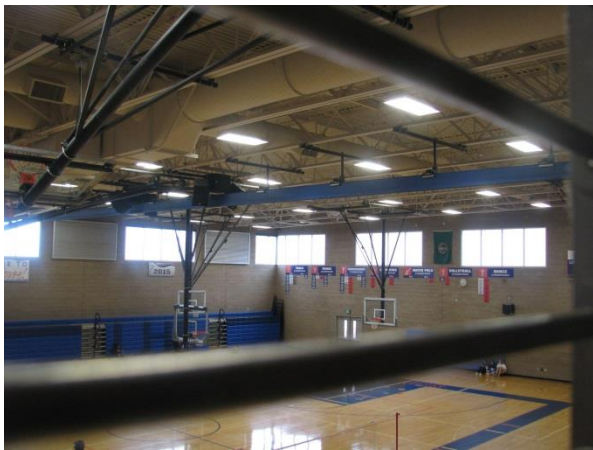
