Child Find

If your child is a preschooler and you have concerns about his or her development, the Enumclaw School District offers free screenings throughout the school year. Children are screened in five developmental areas: **vision, hearing, motor skills, learning and speech/language**. Parents may accompany their children throughout the screening. After the screening, staff will share results and may recommend further evaluation if needed.

ECEAP Preschool

The Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program (ECEAP) is a state-funded preschool program and is free to eligible families who meet income guidelines. We offer half- and full-day classes that meet Monday through Thursday at Southwood Elementary. Parents are encouraged to volunteer in the classroom and extend their child's learning and growth at home.


ECEAP provides early childhood education experiences that include:

Developmental Preschool

Our developmental preschool program focuses on individualized programs and group activities that help qualified children ages 3-5 achieve their maximum potential. Classes are taught by trained special education personnel. Individualized programs may include services by the following:

- Speech Language Pathologist
- Psychologist
- Occupational Therapist
- Physical Therapist
- Nurse

We encourage kindergarten readiness skills with a foundation of reading, mathematics, social skills, motor skills, and music while children explore their environment. A strong emphasis on communication, social, and self-help skills is offered throughout the day.

Our program is provided at no cost for qualified children. **A Child Find screening is necessary to qualify for services.**
