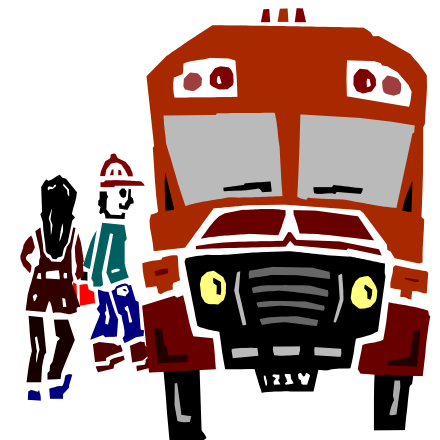

DRIVERS WAGES PER HOUR

SUBSTITUTE DRIVER \$15.00

After working 20 consecutive days the wage increases up to 1st year Drivers Wage at \$16.97 per hour.

APPLICANTS MUST BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE

OBTAIN A CDIP AND CDL

Present a current Washington State Drivers License and a Social Security card. The requirement for a CDIP is to successfully pass the general Knowledge test at DOL. All applicable fees must be paid at the time of applications.

OBTAIN A COMPLETE 5 YEAR DRIVING ABSTRACT FROM DOL

The information from this driving abstract lets us know if there are any infractions on your driving record that would prohibit you from being a school bus driver.

COMPLETE A FBI BACKGROUND CHECK

This background check is obtained at your local police department or State Patrol office and requires a fingerprint procedure. This check will disclose all crimes committed by you against children or other persons.

OBTAIN A DOT PHYSICAL

The DOT requires a physical examination. Paperwork for this exam may be obtained from your doctor's office or a designated clinic. This physical is in accordance with the standards of the Federal Motor Safety Regulations and is required ever 24 months.

SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A SCHOOL BUS

DRIVER TRAINING COURSE

This course is required by WAC 399-144 and is taught by a Washington State Certified Driver Trainer. The course includes classroom instruction of driver requirements, passenger requirements, driving requirements, equipment s, behind the wheel and Special Service. Additional hands-on behind-the wheel training will be taught. All training is paid at minimum wage upon successful completion of the course and actually subbing for us with students on board .

OBTAIN A CURRENT FIRST AID CARD

A first Aid class will give you the tools to use in an emergency situation where First Aid is required. You may obtain this through the school district if there is a class being offered at the time you need it, at a local Red Cross chapter or another local agency.
