### ▶ What is it?

The Family Resource Fair is an opportunity for special education students **of all grade levels** and their families to connect with resources that may offer support and information.

### ▶ Where is it?

The Family Resource Fair will be held in the **Enumclaw High School Library, 226 Semanski, Enumclaw.**

### ▶ Why should you attend?

Students with disabilities and their families will be able to talk directly with agencies and college representatives who can provide various levels of support depending on need. Services such as advocacy, job placement, transition to college or work, and applying for social security are examples of assistance our students can receive.

### ▶ What organizations or resources will be there?

We will have representatives from the Department of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR), Department of Developmental Disabilities (DDD), King County Metro Transit, employment agencies, internship programs, SEPAC (Special Education Parents Advisory Council), ARC of King County, counseling agencies, Special Olympics/recreation programs, and an attorney who specializes in obtaining guardianship.
