Helpful Information

Sports Eligibility

All fall sport participants must complete the following prior to the first day of practice **or you will not be allowed to turn out: All fines must be paid.** Complete the sport specific safety eligibility form, white physical/insurance card, concussion and sudden cardiac arrest forms, and eligibility checklist. Pay the ASB card (\$42), athletic user fee (\$52), and if appropriate pay the football fee (\$35) swimming pool fee (\$105), or water polo fee (\$155). Students must have a 2.0 GPA and passed a minimum of 5 out of 6 classes during last spring semester, as well as being enrolled in at least 5 classes at EHS during the fall semester or the equivalent of that in Running Start, home school, or approved online school. Running Start, home school, and online students need to present proof of previous semester grades and proof of fall enrollment as stated above. Running Start students must also complete the EHS Running Start Athletic Contract. **All freshmen are required to have a physical form that does not say “middle school” on it. These forms are not valid. Doctors may sign the high school form if the middle school physical occurred in the last 12 months.**

Please note: The athletic user fee is \$30.00 for those who qualify for reduced lunch and \$10.00 for those who qualify for free lunch.

Freshmen Orientation ~ August 28 8:30 -1:00 (lunch is not included)

This day is to welcome and support our incoming freshmen. Attendance at orientation will help your student(s) to be prepared for their first day at Enumclaw High School. Your student (s) will receive their class schedule and get a tour of the campus. Please dress comfortable, there will be plenty of walking, and leave bulky items at home, i.e., backpacks, purses etc.

The **PSAT/NMSQT** is a standardized test administered by the College Board and cosponsored by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) in the United States.

The **PSAT/NMSQT** will be offered to freshmen, sophomores and juniors on Wednesday, October 11, 2017 at Enumclaw High School. Interested freshmen and juniors can take this test for a 20.00 fee.

ALL sophomores can take the test at no charge thanks to a generous grant from the Enumclaw Schools Foundation.

Due to the large number of testers, PSAT test administration will take place across campus in a variety of classrooms. A modified class schedule will be used. Details will be coming later. Also, look for additional information at Hornet Days August 24th and 25th.
