### Kindergarten

Please bring supplies to your orientation in September.

- ❖ Earthquake Kit (see back)
- ❖ 2 medium bottles Elmer's Glue (4 oz.)
- ❖ 6 large glue sticks
- ❖ 1 set washable markers, not fine point
- ❖ 1 set colored pencils-Prang recommended
- ❖ Crayons-2 boxes of 16
- ❖ 12 No. 2 pencils/sharpened
- ❖ 1 set dry erase markers
- ❖ 1 pair Fiskars scissors
- ❖ 1 rectangular school box (no larger than  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$ )

- ❖ Standard backpack - large enough to hold a 10" X 12" folder along with lunchbox, etc.

## EARTHQUAKE PREPAREDNESS KIT

If an earthquake were to occur during the school day, the possibility exists that your child(ren) would need to remain at school for up to 72 hours. We are requesting that you provide the selected items listed below for each of your children. Please enclose them in a Ziploc storage bag with your child's name on the outside. These bags will be stored in the individual classrooms. The items will be returned at the end of the school year to be restored for the following school year.

The following are items suggested for the personal survival kit. In making choices, please consider any health needs your child may have.

- 2 ea. 8 oz Juices (canned) with pop tops
- 2 ea. 4 oz Cans of fruit and pop tops, or
- 2 ea. Dried fruit packages (snack size)
- 2 ea. 3 oz Cans of tuna or other luncheon meats in pop top can packages
- 2 ea. Peanut butter or cheese & cracker type snack packages, or
- 2 ea. Granola bars
- 2 ea. Plastic spoons or forks wrapped in napkins
- 2 ea. Individually wrapped moist towelettes

It would be wise to check expiration dates on all food items for the longest shelf life.

Our limited storage area prohibits anything larger than that which will fit in the Ziploc storage bag.

Please send your child's Personal Survival Kit to school in the fall.
