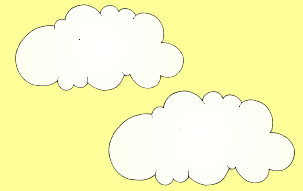


The Bear Facts

Registration requirements are:

*A child must be five years old on or before August 31, 2010.



*A parent must present an original or certified copy of the child's birth certificate.

(Photo copies will not be accepted.)

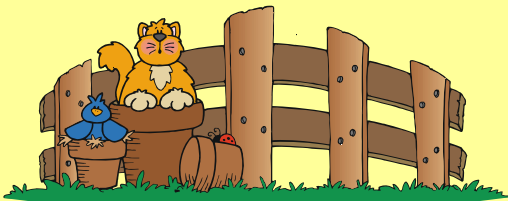


*Washington State immunization requirements must be met which includes the Hepatitis B series, 2 MMR's, a DTP and Polio booster on or after the 4th birthday PLUS 2 doses of Varicella (chicken pox).



*Proof of residence is required at the time of registration.

♥The Enumclaw School District's kindergarten program is a half-day program that consists of morning and afternoon sessions held five days a week. Boundaries for the AM/PM classes are determined by transportation.



Full day programs are being offered at the cost of \$250.00 per month for ten months. A class will be offered at Kibler if a 20 student enrollment is reached! The registration fee (\$250) is required at the time of sign-up for full-day and will be used as the June 2011 payment.

Student Drop Off and Student Pick Up Procedures
"Friendly Reminder"

To ensure the safety of students in the morning and in the afternoon please follow the procedure for vehicle drop off and vehicle pick up of students on Kibler Avenue that is outlined below. We appreciate your understanding, patience, and cooperation during the fifteen minutes of busy traffic time on Kibler Avenue before and after school. Doors open at 8:45 AM and we ask that students not be on campus before this time as no adult supervision is available.

We are asking that vehicles dropping off or vehicles picking up students to drive north on LaFromboise St. toward Kibler Avenue. When arriving at Kibler Avenue turn left at the stop sign onto Kibler Avenue and pull next to the curb as far west as you are able to in the area designated by street signs stating "Student Drop Off No Parking". This area is for drop off and pick up of students. The curb in this area is red. Please continue to remember to pull up as far as possible so that several vehicles can drop off or pick up students at one time. This area is intended for the driver to stay in the vehicle and is not a parking area. Your child will line up on the sidewalk by the bike racks at the end of the day until he/she sees your vehicle. As soon as your child sees your vehicle he/she will then be able to enter your vehicle from the sidewalk. Please remind your child to exit and enter your vehicle from the curb side nearest the school building for his/her safety. Students may use the door by the bike racks to enter the building from 8:45 AM to 9:00 AM.

If you walk to the area outside of the office to drop off or pick up a student you may park in the parking lot or on the street where the curb indicates that you may do so. The yellow curbed areas have street signs that state "No Parking Any Time" or "No Parking, Stopping,
